4. Consider Authorizing District Manager to Execute All Necessary Documents to Secure a Small Community Wastewater Planning Grant from the State Water Resources Control **Board:** On April 2015 we turned in a financial assistant application that was made available because of the Proposition 1 monies that were being allocated to water and wastewater through the State Water Resources Control Board. We have received the final paperwork for that application and now need the board to authorize the District Managers signature to secure the grant for half a million dollars to do some work on the wastewater side of our enterprise. Some of the work that we are looking at to have done with the monies is a sewer cleaning and camera inspection of our entire system to find places in our system that need to be replaced. We also are planning on having our Sewer System Management Plan updated by PACE Engineering, relining our sludge lagoon making improvements to the system. We may also need to do an income survey depending on the results on the data that will be coming out in 2016. If the income survey comes back in our favor then we will receive 75-100% percent loan forgiveness and could open up financial assistance on the water side so we will be able to look for funds to make necessary improvements. This grant is for the sewer side only and most of the work will be done by pace engineering and the rest of the work will be put out to bid. District Manager Willie Rodriguez summarized the guidelines and time frames for the grant money and answered questions. Director Borkey moved to Authorize District Manager to Execute All Necessary Documents to Secure a Small Community Wastewater Planning

Grant from the State Water Resources Control Board. Director Hamlin seconded the motion.

 - Had a training through CSDA Webinars for AB 1825 Harassment Prevention and AB 1234
 Ethics Trainings, still need to have some board members signed up for these trainings so
 we can check the trainings off of the Transparency Checklist through SDLF.
 - Have a crew working over at the Waste Water Treatment Facility; they are working on a re-roof on our main building. We discovered some leaks after the wind storm in February; they should have it finished next week sometime.
 - Still working on USDA Letter of Compliance.
 - Working on getting a 20 horse aerator installed in the Waste Water Lagoon, it should make it more efficiently, helping us create fewer solids.
 - Will be scheduling Standing Committee Meetings in December for all committees, most likely will be held the second and third week.
 - The sludge is out of the ponds, they wanted it all the material out by October 15th but we had some that was to runny to move so we had a company come in to move it but they were unable to get it all pumped so we had to rent an excavator to move the rest so we were done midday October 17th. We may get fined by the board for not meeting the deadline but haven't yet heard if they will do so or not. The material that was dry enough to move is in concrete drying beds because they were too wet to have hauled out so we will put it back in the drying beds on May 15th of next year to let it dry next year. After talking with Burney Disposal we will be allowed to mix the sludge, after we do our sampling, with waste at the dump site to be hauled.
 - Have been talking to Barber Webb out of Ashland about relining the sludge pond, working on getting some quotes together. It would be putting a new liner over the existing liner, so we wouldn't have to tear everything out to replace it, will not be able to do this until we get the pond completely pumped out.
